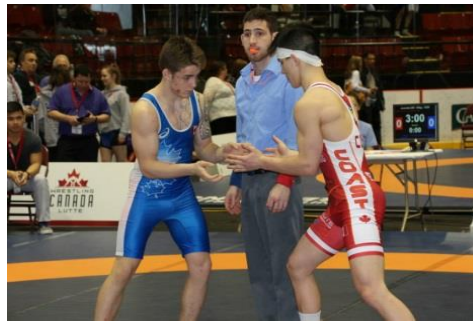

More Medals for New Brunswick as Men & Women Grapple in Greco-Roman

Fredericton – April 13, 2015

The final day of the 2015 Cadet / Juvenile Canadian Championships concluded with more New Brunswick athletes being crowned Canadian Champions. Both Juvenile Men and Women took to the mats at the Aitken Centre to compete in Greco-Roman. This is the second year the championship has included a women's Greco-Roman division.

In total, 10 New Brunswick wrestlers earned medals in the discipline. Both Cedric Arseneau (Men's 115kg) of Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst and Kris Beerenfenger (130kg) of Black Bears Wrestling Club captured Gold Medals in the men's division, while Kennedy MacIsaac (46kg) of Mountaintop Wrestling Club earned the lone Gold in the women's competition.

On the men's side, Tyler Richard (46kg) of Kent Wrestling Club wrestled to a Silver Medal finish, while Jeremy Poirier of Kent Wrestling Club, and Antoni Mallet (54kg), Mikael Rousseau (63kg), and Justin Vinet (69kg) of Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst each earned Bronze.

Tanya Blanchard (46kg) of Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst, and Mackenzie Smallwood (49kg) of Mountaintop Wrestling each took a Silver Medal in the Women's division to round out the province's medal haul.

Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst finished second in the men's team standings 22 points, behind Guru Gobind Singh Wrestling Club of British Columbia.
