NB ATHLETES SCORE 6 FREESTYLE & 5 GRECO-ROMAN MEDALS

This past weekend 23 wrestlers from four New Brunswick wrestling clubs participated in the 2016 Cadet / Juvenile Canadian Championships in Calgary, Alberta. Wrestlers from Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst, Hampton Wrestling Club, Kent Wrestling Club, and Mountaintop Wrestling Club each competed in both the Freestyle and Greco-Roman disciplines, and earned a combined total of 11 medals.

Felysha Doucette-Daigle of Kent Wrestling Club scored the lone Gold Medal in Freestyle. Doucette-Daigle earned her first National Title by defeating all four of her competitors in the Cadet Girls 90kg division. Also claiming Silver in the category was Katy Doucet-Hebert of Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst. Other female Freestyle medalist include Annabelle Boudreau (Cadet 43kg - Silver) and Tania Blanchard (Juvenile 46kg - Bronze) of Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst, and Jasmine Thebeau (Juvenile 65kg - Bronze) of Kent Wrestling Club.

Alex Cormier of Kent Wrestling Club scored the lone Medal for New Brunswick in Boy's Freestyle. Cormier captured a Bronze in the Cadet 54kg division.

New Brunswick Athletes also enjoyed success in both Boy's and Girl's Greco-Roman Championships. Mountaintop's Justin Shannon captured a Gold in the Boy's 85kg class. Shannon was also named outstanding Male Wrestler in the Boy's Greco-Roman competition. Also earning medals in Greco-Roman were Chris O'Toole (Boy's 100kg - Silver) from Hampton Wrestling Club, and Mikeal Rousseau (Boy's 63kg - Bronze), Tania Blanchard (Girl's 46kg - Silver), and Maryse Arseneau (Girl's 70kg - Bronze) of Club de Lutte Acadie Bathurst.
