The New Brunswick U18 Wrestling Team held their first training session this past Saturday in Moncton. The team, which consist of 17 athletes from across the province, stepped on the mats together for the first time at Crandall University. The one day clinic, which was led by the 2017 Canada Summer Games Coaching Staff, allowed the selected athletes the opportunity to work closely with some of New Brunswick's best coaches.

"The U18 program is going to be very beneficial for wrestling within New Brunswick." says LNBW President Chris Falconer. "It was great to see this pool of wrestlers working together."

Built around the principles of Wrestling Canada Lutte's Long-Term Athlete Development (LTAD) model, the U18 Wrestling Team will provide New Brunswick wrestlers in the Train to Train and Train to Compete stages with the knowledge, skills, and experience needed to achieve national and international success through access to elite level training camps and competitions.

The team will join together once again on June 4, in Rexton, NB. The team will participate in another one day clinic at Eleanor W. Graham Middle School in preparation for the 2016 Down-East Dual at Lincoln Academy in Newcastle, Maine on June 18.
