

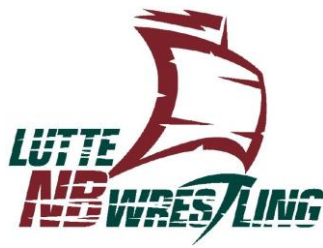

1. Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this document is to establish the guidelines and procedures that Lutte New Brunswick Wrestling (LNBW) and its members must adhere to when participating and/or hosting any tournament, festival, demonstration, workshop, camp, or clinic sanctioned or recognized by the association.

2. Scope of Policy

- 2.1 Policy 106 applies to all members of LNBW as described in the Articles of the LNBW Constitution.

3. Language

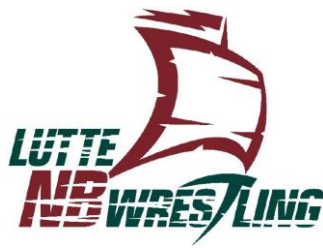
- 3.1 Where there is a difference in interpretation between the French and English version of this document, then the English version shall prevail.

4. Sanctioned Events

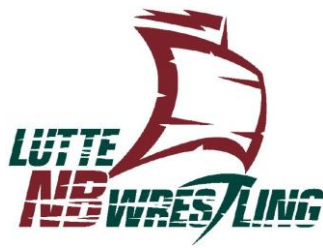
- 4.1 LNBW recognizes the following events in which members may participate in while insured under the association's insurance plan:
- Events hosted within New Brunswick which are hosted by LNBW, or an affiliate club which has received prior permission to host the event.
 - Events hosted outside New Brunswick which are sanctioned by the recognized Wrestling Provincial/Territorial/State Sport Organization.
 - Events hosted outside of New Brunswick which are sanctioned by Wrestling Canada Lutte (WCL).
 - Events hosted outside of New Brunswick which are sanctioned by United World Wrestling (UWW).

5. Event Sanctioning Procedures

- 5.1 Wrestling clubs interest in hosting an event under LNBW sanctioning within New Brunswick must be affiliated with the association, and be a member in good standing during the year they in which the club is hosting the event.
- 5.2 New Brunswick athletes, coaches, and officials participating in a LNBW sanctioned or recognized event must be a registered member, in good standing, of the association.



- 5.3 All athletes, coaches and officials from outside of New Brunswick who participate in a LNBW sanctioned event must be a registered member, in good standing, of their provincial, territorial, or state wrestling association.
- 5.4 All events involving more than two (2) clubs must be sanctioned by LNBW.
- 5.5 LNBW affiliated clubs can receive permission to host a sanctioned event by submitting an Event Hosting Application to the LNBW Office. Event Hosting Applications can be obtained from the LNBW Staff.
- 5.6 All events sanctioned by LNBW must use Officials who are members in good standing of the association.
 - 5.6.1 The assignment of Officials for LNBW sanctioned events will be conducted by the Officials Representative.
 - 5.6.2 The assignment of Officials will consider the geographical location of the event, and use give local officials when possible to mitigate travel expenses.
- 5.7 A completed physical, or electronic, copy of the Event Hosting Application must be submitted to the LNBW Office at least fourteen (14) days prior to the start of the event. Once received and approved, LNBW will add the event to the LNBW and WCL schedule of events.
- 5.8 The host club must notify LNBW if alcoholic beverages are to be served at the event venue. Failure to do so will void the liability insurance provided by the sanction.
- 5.9 LNBW shall not be held responsible for the operation or financial commitment of any committee, individual, organizing body or wrestling competition which has not received prior and explicit sanction from the association, or which otherwise acts outside the constitution, the bylaws, or policies of the association.
- 5.10 The host club must ensure that all precautions are taken to ensure the sanctioned activity takes place in a safe environment for all taking into consideration the security of participants and spectators.



6. Event Sanctioning Fee

6.1 A flat rate will be charged to the host of any event sanctioned by LNBW. The structure of the sanctioning fee is as follows:

Category	Description	Fee
<i>Domestic Event</i>	Any event that involves participants from more than two (2) LNBW affiliated clubs	\$40.00
<i>Regional Event</i>	Any event that involves participants from outside of New Brunswick.	\$60.00
<i>National Event</i>	Any age group Canadian Championships, or the Canada East Wrestling Festival	\$200.00

6.2 The sanctioning fee must be received by the LNBW Office at least seven (7) days prior to the start of the event.

7. Penalties for Non-compliance

7.1 Failure to apply for sanction will void LNBW insurance coverage for all participants in the unsanctioned event.

7.2 The host club shall be refused sanction from LNBW for a minimum of two years.

7.3 The LNBW Board of Directors may exact further penalties at their discretion.

Notes:

- LNBW Membership insurance coverage is extended only for members of LNBW member clubs participating with their club. Where athletes participate/compete for their school, their school should extend coverage as LNBW Insurance does not apply, unless their school is a registered LNBW club member.
- Coaches and officials participate in school events and competitions that are not sanctioned by LNBW then LNBW Insurance does not apply.
